

Returning PSP screening forms

1. If you have 1-150 screening forms, use the postage paid return envelope (manila) included in your order to return the completed forms.
2. If you have 150 + screening forms, use the return mailing box included in your order to return the completed screening forms. Attach the enclosed adhesive postage paid label to the box.
3. Your mail carrier with the United States Postal Service will pick up the envelope/box with your regular outgoing mail.
4. You will still be required to complete the cover sheet for each group of screening forms mailed. (See button 11 on the PSP Forms web page.)
5. Do not return any blank screening forms or unopened fluoride varnish.
